Mr. Richard Stancato, age 85, passed away on Saturday, November 14, 2015 at the Presbyterian Home for Central NY, Inc.

Born in Utica on June 22, 1930, Richard was the son of the late Peter and Mary Stancato. He was raised and educated in Utica. A veteran of the United States Army, Rich served his country from 1952-1954 during the Korean Conflict.
