Robert J. Berg of New Hartford, NY died on July 28, 2018. He was born in Detroit Michigan, a son of the late Lester and Gertrude Lyons Berg. Robert served in the US Air Force as a flight navigator, radio operator and Airman 2nd Class over 4 years during the Korean War. He attended college at the University of Detroit and graduated with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering. He then was offered an electrical engineering job in Utica, NY at General Electric where he met his future wife, Carmella Nassimos. They married in 1960 at St. Basil's Melkite Church in Utica, NY. Robert was a communicant of St. John the Evangelist Church in New Hartford, NY. He worked as an electrical engineer for General Electric for 32 years until his retirement. His hobbies included reading, doing Sudoku and puzzles, computers, and traveling cross-country. He also did volunteer work for AARP preparing taxes for seniors and volunteered in the soup kitchen and with local charities.
