



Robert F. "Bob" Manfredo

November 29, 1934 - July 4, 2014

Mr. Robert F. "Bob" Manfredo, age 79, passed away on Friday, July 4, 2014 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with the support and blessings of his family.

Born in Utica on November 29, 1934, Robert was the son of the late Frank and Helen (Caputo) Manfredo. Raised and educated locally, he attended T.R. Proctor High School. A proud veteran of the United States Army, Bob honorably served his country from 1953-1954 stationed stateside. On March 2, 1957 he married the former Genevieve "Jean" Paul with whom he shared 57 years in a union graced with love, affection, and a lifetime of wonderful memories.

Bob began his career as a Utica Firefighter in February of 1957. His unwavering work ethic, dedication, and commitment to his profession was evident as he was promoted up through the ranks to his final rank of Fire Chief, the capacity in which he served from 1984 to 1996. Bob earned many awards during his years of public service, and was well respected in the community. In addition to his career in the Utica Fire Department Bob was also a State Fire Instructor and taught many classes for members of local area fire departments. He was proud of the fact that he was motivated to bettering himself and took the time during his working years to study independently. His life's work revolved around the Fire Department's philosophy, which he upheld until his retirement in March of 1996. As the patriarch of his family, Bob's greatest passion was to provide for them. He was

a generous and benevolent man of integrity, was quick-witted and loyal, especially in his friendships. He looked forward to Tuesday lunches with his close friends, Frank Mazza, and Ron Roman, and visits to the Turning Stone Casino accompanied by his wife, where they enjoyed the entertainment. A truly industrious man, when time allowed he took pleasure in playing a round of golf or reading a book, especially favoring subjects based on history and the events of WWII. He was a member of the New York State Fire Chief's Association and Engine Eleven. Bob was also a faith-filled man who accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior.

Bob is survived by his beloved wife, Jean; his sons and daughters-in-law, Robert and Donna Manfredo of New Hartford, and Francis and Gail Manfredo of Marcy; his daughter and son-in-law, Tammy and Jon Buck of Blossvale; his adored grandchildren who affectionately referred to him as Papa Chief, Robert and Megan Manfredo, Paul Manfredo and fiancée Shannon Gallagher; Mariah, and Morgan Manfredo; Danielle, and Nicole Sisti, and Dylan Buck; and his precious great-granddaughter, Norah. He leaves a wonderful sister-in-law Joan Paul, who offered her assistance in the healthcare of her brother-in-law and two special nieces, Dr. Susan Horling, and Leslie Paul who gave outstanding support and love to their uncle during his time of need. He also leaves several nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, and longtime friends Don Paciello, and Paul Daniels, "the Sunday bread man". He was predeceased by his sister, Rosemary Greco; his brother-in-law, Raymond Paul; and his beloved nephew, David T. Paul.
