June 4, 1951 - November 19, 2008

Mr. Robert P. Trevisani, age 57, of Utica, passed away on Wednesday, November 19, 2008 at Upstate University Medical Center in Syracuse with the support of his family.

Born in Utica on June 4, 1951, Robert is the son of Edmund, Sr. and Rose Mary (Graziano) Trevisani. Raised and educated locally, he was a 1969 graduate of T. R. Proctor High School.
