



## Robin W. Abrial

Mr. Robin W. Abrial, age 57, passed away on Tuesday, January 13, 2015 in the comfort of his home.

Born in Utica on July 18, 1957, Robin was the son of Carol (Cushman) Abrial and the late William Abrial. Raised and educated locally, he attended Miller Street Elementary School and Utica Free Academy High School. 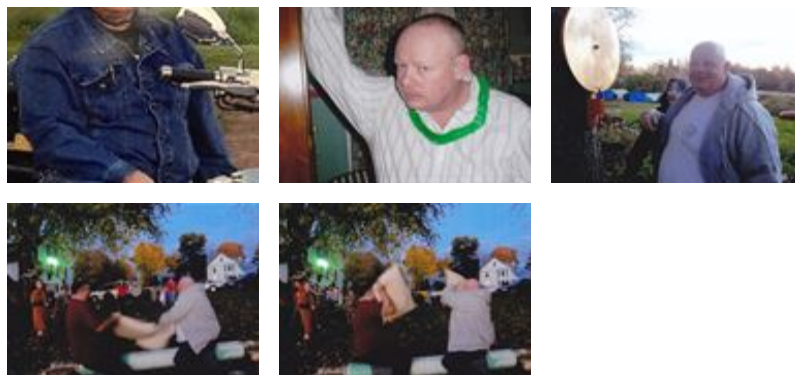
