



Rocco Barroncini

December 15, 1957 - November 8, 2007

Mr. Rocco Barroncini, age 49, a longtime Utican and most recently of Barneveld, passed away on Thursday, November 8, 2007 at the Upstate Cerebral Palsy N. Gage IRA with his loving family by his side.

Born in Brooklyn, NY on December 15, 1957, Rocco was the son of the late Donald J. and Madeline (Mayo) Barroncini. He was raised and educated in Utica and was a graduate of Utica Free Academy.

Rocco worked in the packaging department of the ARC for many years, and he will be remembered for his outgoing personality, strong spirit, and keen sense of humor. He enjoyed socializing at family gatherings and he cherished the comradery of friends and relatives. A self-sufficient person, he often rode his bike around town which reflected one of his greatest efforts in life --- to maintain his own dignity and independent lifestyle. He also cared for and loved his feline companion.

Rocco is survived by his sister and brother-in-law, Diane and Albert Powers, Sr. of Rome; his brothers and sisters-in-law, Joseph and Tammy Barroncini of Utica, Patrick Barroncini of Whitesboro, Anthony Barroncini of Rome, Ronald and Nadine Barroncini of Utica, and John Barroncini and Katherine Bootie of Vernon Center.
