



Ronald W. "Ronnie" Risucci

May 10, 1935 - October 15, 2012

Mr. Ronald W. "Ronnie" Risucci, age 77, of Deerfield, joined his beloved wife in Heaven when he passed away unexpectedly on Monday, October 15, 2012 in the comfort and dignity of his home.

Ronald was born in Utica on May 10, 1935, the son of the late Michael and Mary (Salerno) Risucci. Raised and educated in Utica, he was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. On January 24, 1959 he married the former Marion E. Waterman who passed away on Christmas Eve, December 24, 2009; the couple shared 50 loving years together as the light of each other's eyes.
