



Ronald K. Giruzzi

February 6, 1966 - March 29, 2010

Mr. Ronald K. Giruzzi, age 44, of Utica, passed away on Monday, March 29, 2010 at the Abraham House after a courageous battle. At the time of his passing his devoted family was by his side.

Born in New Hartford on February 6, 1966, Ronald is the son of Joseph Giruzzi and Randi (Zammiello) Giruzzi. Raised and educated locally, he was a graduate of J.mF. Kennedy High School/Class of 1984. At one time he was wed to Angela Graziano.

Ronald worked alongside his father and uncles with his family's concern in the cattle trade industry. Family was precious to him, and his loved ones referred to him as the "Golden Boy". He enjoyed good food, especially his sister Julie's cuisine. He held a dry sense of humor, found insight in reading mysteries and novels, and appreciated classic movies of the 20's and 30's. He was a parishioner of St. Mark's Church.

Ronald is survived by his daughter, Brianna Giruzzi; his parents, Randi Giruzzi of Utica, and Joseph and Mary Giruzzi of Lowville; and his maternal grandmother, Jayne Zammiello of Utica. Survivors also include Julie Giruzzi-Mosca, Joseph Mosca, Joey and Angelo Mosca, Joseph Giruzzi, Jr., Linda Borruso, and Jena Giruzzi. Ronald also leaves Danielle and Jacqui; many aunts, uncles, and cousins, with special acknowledgment of Aunt Tammy Zammiello, and his special cousin, Franny Giruzzi; his godmother, Liz "Goomie" Zasa; and many special friends. He was predeceased by his paternal grandmother, Mary (Dote) Giruzzi; paternal grandfather, Frank R.

Giruzzi; and maternal grandfather, Kenneth Zammiello.

The family expresses sincere appreciation to the entire staff and volunteers of the Abraham House, and to the members of Hospice & Palliative Care, Inc. who offered love and comfort to Ronald during his last days. Thanks also to Dr. Thomas Coyle and his staff for their professionalism and care.

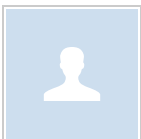
