UTICA – Mr. Ronnie Allen, age 69, was called home to be with his loving God on Sunday, August 31, 2025, following a brief illness.

Born in Utica on October 26, 1955, Ronnie was the son of the late Milton and Mary (Dixon) Allen. He attended Columbus Elementary School and was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. A proud U.S. veteran, he enlisted in the Navy in 1972 and later served with the Navy Reserve and the National Guard.

At one time, Ronnie was wed to Philomena Taurisano and from that union came the blessing of two daughters, Laronda and Renee. He also shared a relationship with Kimberly Warner, and together they were blessed with seven children.

Ronnie held a wide range of local positions throughout his career. In his younger years, Ronnie was an exceptional athlete, excelling in track and field. He was a member of the Greater Holy Temple, where he attended church faithfully. One of his favorite sayings was, "What's love got to do with it?"

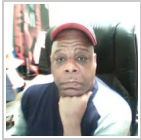
