UTICA/DEERFIELD BEACH, FL – Rosaleen “Rosalie” (Spina) Colacicco, age 93, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, December 18, 2024.

Born in Utica, NY on September 27, 1931, Rosalie was the daughter of the late Rocco and Antoinette (Cerullo) Spina. She was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School and furthered her studies at Utica College.

On February 23, 1951, in Blessed Sacrament Church, Rosalie wed Joseph E. Colacicco. The couple shared in a devoted union of nearly 65 years prior to Joseph’s passing on March 26, 2016.

Always dressed in the latest fashion, Rosalie was a pillar in the community. She made friends wherever she went. She spent many summers at Higby Hills Country Club, and later Yahnundasis Golf Club. You could always find her ready for a game of cards, even in her final months.
