



## Rose (Scaduto) Ventimiglia

September 12, 1920 - February 13, 2007

Mrs. Rose (Scaduto) Ventimiglia, age 86, of New Hartford, passed away on Tuesday, February 13, 2007 at the Presbyterian Home for CNY, Inc. At the time of her passing her loving family was by her side.

She was born on September 12, 1920 in Chicago, IL, the daughter of the late Antonio and Concetta (Rizzo) Scaduto. Her parents returned to Bagheria, Sicily in 1921, where she was raised and educated. She never allowed her disabilities to dampen her spirits. Rose was very well loved by her many friends and by the staff and administrators of the Presbyterian Home who enjoyed her good nature and pleasant attitude. She was very proud of her children and cherished her children and grandchildren. Rose loved music and dancing and could often be found singing throughout the halls of the Presbyterian Home and at the various musical performances

there. She was a devoted Catholic and a parishioner of St. Anthony of Padua Church.

Rose is survived by her daughter, Cecelia M. Mazzatti; and her son and daughter-in-law, Daniel A. & MaryAnn Ventimiglia. She was devoted to her grandchildren, Mary Christine Mazzatti, Pamela Rose Mazzatti, Robert Guy and Jennifer Mazzatti; her grandchildren of Portland, Maine, David and Lori Ventamiglia, Christopher Ventimiglia and Stacy Sullivan; and Michelle Langone, locally. Also surviving are her great-grandchildren, Nicole Mazzatti, Jacob Mazzatti, and Zachary Smith, who were a joy to her. She leaves special friends, Connie Mineo and Mary Inserra. She was predeceased by her two brothers, Gaetano and Joseph Scaduto; and her son-in-law, Robert Michael "Bob" Mazzatti.
