



## Rose (Cosentine) Maggiolino

February 2, 1914 - October 10, 2011

Mrs. Rose (Cosentine) Maggiolino, age 97, of Utica, passed away on Monday, October 10, 2011 at the Presbyterian Home for CNY, Inc. with the love and support of her family by her side.

Rose was born in Utica on February 2, 1914, the daughter of the late Agazio and Francesca (Gagliardi) Cosentine. On July 1, 1940 she married Thomas A. Maggiolino with whom she shared 44 years until his passing on July 8, 1984; their wonderful relationship was built around love, respect, and happy memories.

Rose worked over 20 years as a Unit Secretary at St. Luke's Memorial Hospital, retiring in 1978. As a young girl, she was raised by the Franciscan Sisters who taught her the art of sewing which she utilized throughout her life, making her children's clothing, developing her talents to include wedding gowns, bridesmaid's dresses, and other attire, all with the creativity and precision of a master seamstress. Rose lived a good life and was blessed with a charitable heart and hand, graced with a cheerful and outgoing nature. She enjoyed dancing her whole life through, and was passionate about her pastime of friendly games of chance. During the 1960's and 70's, Rose enjoyed many seasons at their summer home at White Lake. She practiced her faith at her neighborhood parish of St. Agnes Church.

Rose is survived by her daughter, Mary Lou Kunkel and companion Drago Grcic; and her son, Thomas F. "Timmy" Maggiolino. Always in her thoughts was the memory of her daughter-in-law, Rosalie Maggiolino, who preceded

her in death. She also leaves her grandchildren, Krysta and Mike Carney, Jack T. Sr. and Katie Kunkel, Thomas "Timmy" and Kristin Maggiolino, and Dean and Jennifer Maggiolino; and her great-grandchildren, Michaela and Nikolas Carney; Jack T. Also left to mourn her memory is Bonnie Purdy who she loved as a second daughter; many nieces, nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews.
