UTICA - Mrs. Rose Mary (Graziano) Trevisani, age 94, passed away on Thursday, May 9, 2019 with her loving family by her side, and is now in heaven “dancing with her husband, Ed (Dad)”.

Born in Utica on February 11, 1925, Rose Mary was the daughter of the late Philip and Congetta (Gigliotti) Graziano. She was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1943. On September 6, 1948 at St. Mary of Mt. Carmel Church, she married Edmund T. Trevisani. She was a wonderful Mom and he was a devoted Dad. They had a beautiful life together and they lived for their children. Edmund was a proud member of the Utica Police Department until his retirement. Part of Rose’s heart went with him when he passed on September 21, 2011, after 63 years of marriage.

Rose’s primary role in life was to take care of her husband and children. She did this tirelessly and with unending love. She was also known by many as “the face” of Hawaiian Holiday, as she worked alongside her son, Richard. She was an amazing woman, and a dedicated mother to her 10 children. She knew the heart and mind of each and every one of them, and she nurtured and supported each of her children’s ventures and visions. They, in turn, all have precious memories of her enduring love, encouragement, and endorsement of all their endeavors. Rose’s mindset was focused on her family life and keeping everyone together. A woman of character, she was strong and steadfast, and she had very few distractions in life to prevent her from being a wonderful wife and a wise mother. Her children adored her and

appreciated her humility, and they were her riches in life. In earlier years, Ed and Rose hosted parties, holidays, and sometimes they were “their own party”. Saturday nights belonged to them, and together they danced those nights away at the Sons of Italy and the Moose Lodge. In her later years, Rose could be found in the Rat Pack Room at Delmonico’s Italian Steakhouse with her son, Steven, enjoying good food, family and friends, thanks to the generosity of John and Joanne. She especially looked forward to her regular Friday night visits which began on Rose and Eddie’s 50th wedding anniversary in 1998 and which continued for many years up to the present day... as well as many other celebratory events, always hosted at Delmonico’s, due to the graciousness of her son in law, John Wade. A communicant of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish, Rose knew the Lord and experienced his blessings. She embraced the cardinal virtues of practicality, justice, and kindness, and instilled them into the lives of her children.

Steven became her "partner" in life. He cared for her and was always by her side. He was a son like no other.
