



## Mrs. Rose (Reile) Ryder

March 10, 1930 - January 16, 2017

UTICA - Mrs. Rose (Reile) Ryder passed away on Monday, January 16, 2017 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with her loving family and her friends at her side.

Born in Utica, Rose was the daughter of the late Raymond and Lucy (Licari) Reile. Raised and educated locally, she was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. At one time, she was married to the late Peter J. Macri, Sr., a union that was blessed with children. On August 10, 1974 she entered into a second union when she wed Charles L. "Charlie" Ryder with whom she shared 34 years in a union filled with love, devotion, and friendship. Charlie passed away on January 14, 2009.

During her working years, Rose held positions at the Joseph & Feiss Company and M.V.C.C. She also volunteered as an usher at the Stanley Theater and also at polling stations during voting and elections. Throughout her life, Rose maintained her physical fitness and youthful spirit. She enjoyed socializing and loved spending time with family and friends. Her home was her castle and the center of family dinners and holidays. She enjoyed bowling and was proud of her "high scores". She also loved to dance, and travel, often welcoming the warmth and comfort of the ocean in Florida and Hawaii.

Rose is survived by her daughter, Sandy (Macri) McNamara of MA; her sons, Peter J. Macri, Jr., and Frank R. Macri, both of Utica; and her granddaughter, Erin Claire McNamara of MA and her father, John McNamara. She also leaves her many nieces and nephews, with special mention of Raymond and

Annette Reale and his son, Ray; Renee Crouse and her daughter Kayla; and Rosemary Vasile; numerous great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, and in-laws of the Ryder and Macri families. She was predeceased by her brother, Joseph A. Reale; and her sister-in-law, Carmella Vasile.
