Mrs. Rose A. (Ciufu) Visalli, age 75, of Utica, passed away on Saturday, June 9, 2007, at the Faxon-St. Luke's Healthcare Center.

Born in Tufo Di Minturno, Italy on July 24, 1931, Rose was the daughter of the late Henry and Maria (Rasile) Ciufu. She settled in the United States with her family in 1947.
