



Roseanne (Macri) Klein

May 6, 1943 - November 18, 2023

UTICA - Roseanne (Macri) Klein, age 80, passed away on Saturday, November 18, 2023 after a short battle with cancer. At the time of her passing, she was in the hearts of her loving family.

Born in Utica on May 6, 1943, Roseanne was the daughter of the late James "Jimmy" and Anna (Miligrano) Macri. She attended Brandege Grammar School and T.R. Proctor High School.

On July 13, 1968, she wed Edward A. "Ed" Klein. Together they shared over 46 years of marriage prior to his passing on March 29, 2015.

Roseanne's career began at the Masonic Home in the dietary department. She then was employed at the Sunset Nursing Home in the dietary department, the position from which she retired after 20 years.

Known for being "sharp as a tack," she could be feisty and had no filter, yet she balanced these traits with an open and loving heart, always showing concern and care. Roseanne's sarcastic humor often caught the attention of her children. The casino was her second home; slots were her game of choice, and dining at their restaurants was a bonus! She was a RUNNER, always on the go. She saw no value in staying home, priding herself on never needing assistance and remaining independent.

Roseanne had a fondness for watching "Days of Our Lives," the WWE, "I Love Lucy," and "Everybody Loves Raymond." She was the glue that held the family together, especially during holidays, barbecues, parties, and any celebration, leaving behind "Rosie-isms" to last a lifetime.

Her spirituality was evident in her Catholic faith, and she always prayed for others.

Roseanne is survived by her children and their loves, Edward, Jr. and Lisa Klein, Laurie Klein and Randy Mazzie, Lisa and Kevin Rimmer, Lynn Darling, and Vincent and Lara Klein; she raised Vincent with much love and guidance, that was "her boy" and he will always hold her in his heart. She was a devoted grandmother to Brianna, and Matthew; Stephanie Klein and Juan David; Steph was always there for her grandma, no one could take her place, and Steph was "her girl," Gino Mazzie, Bella Mazzie and Alex; Corey and Allison Klein, Brandon Carney, Richard Rood, Anthony Klein, and Daniel "Jr." Darling. She also leaves behind her great-grandchildren, Jaiden, Santino, Carter, Avianna, Chase, Zerenity, Anastasia, Elise, Zowey, Mikenna, and Declan. Roseanne cherished the memory of her great-grandson, Braylen Michael Klein, who became an angel on March 11, 2013. She is also remembered by her sister, Diane Cornell (the late Jim Cornell); and her sister-in-law, Sandra Macri. She was predeceased by her siblings, Barbara Catrombone, and Vincent Macri. 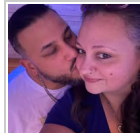
