



Rose M. (Moses) Crigger

December 1, 1914 - November 20, 2008

Mrs. Rose M. (Moses) Crigger, age 93, of Utica, passed away on Thursday, November 20, 2008 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center.

Born in New York Mills, on December 1, 1914, Rose was the daughter of the late Gabriel and Julia (Chamoun) Moses. She was raised and educated locally, attending Utica Free Academy. On April 12, 1948 Rose wed Boyd L. Crigger; they were a well-matched couple who shared a loving union of 56 years until Boyd's passing on May 21, 2004.

Rose's 35 year work history included positions as a stenographer, bookkeeper, and office manager for Mack Truck, Firestone, and the Dairyman's League, from which she retired. She was a member of the St. Mary's Guild and other organizations at her parish, St. Louis Gonzaga Church. With the love of God in her heart, she was extremely supportive of those in need, and the generosity of her parish was rewarding for her.
