

## Mrs. Rosemarie (Baker) Falk

July 17, 1946 - January 3, 2016

Mrs. Rosemarie P. (Baker) Falk, age 69, went home peacefully on Sunday, January 3, 2016 when she passed away in the privacy of her home with her family by her side.

Born in Frankfort, NY on July 17, 1946, Rosemarie was the daughter of the late John and Madeline (Vilardi) Baker. Holidays were especially meaningful and significant for Rosemarie, and she looked forward to having everyone together. A candid and expressively vocal person, you always knew where you stood with her. Her body language and gestures were so animated that you couldn't help but laugh and feel good in her company. She was also hip to today's trends, from

music and dancing, to contemporary language and social media jargon, to tattoos! Rosemarie was not one to be “behind the times”, and she was forever young at heart. She enjoyed shopping for her household and her pets, especially “Midnight”. During her spare time, she faithfully followed her favorite ‘soap opera’, “Days of Our Lives” that portrayed true-to-life situations. As a Catholic, Rosemarie relied on Jesus during the good times and bad times of her life. She prayed to the saints and relied on their power of intercession. Rosemarie is survived by her husband, John; her daughters and son-in-law, Theresa Campese, Tina Caputo, Madeline Caputo, and Marie and James Ware; her grandchildren, Chad Albright; Angel Looman, and Brittney Doherty; Gabriella Baker, Michael Santmyer, Nicholas Santmyer, Janessa Linder, Rodney Ware, and Kailani Ware; and several great-grandchildren. She will also be remembered by her sisters, Florence Baker, Diane Baker, and Kathleen Baker; and her brothers, Ricky Baker, Ron Baker, and John Baker. 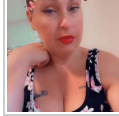

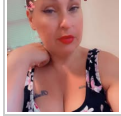

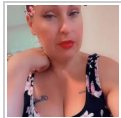
