



Sadie (Scalzo) Wilson

Mrs. Sadie (Scalzo) Wilson, age 94, of Utica, passed away after a brief illness on Sunday, August 17, 2008 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center.

Born in Utica on November 20, 1913, Sadie was the daughter of the late Carmine and Maria (Barratta) Scalzo. She was raised and educated in Utica. Sadie was married to Harry Wert, and as a couple, they resided in Rhode Island where they operated a men's clothing store where she was a talented seamstress. They later retired to California where they lived until Harry's passing in 1958. Sadie returned to Utica to be closer to her family who affectionately knew her as "Aunt Sally". Sadie was a woman of quiet demeanor, very kind, and appreciative of all the thoughtful efforts of her family; she loved them true-heartedly. She was a communicant of St. Anthony of Padua Church where she faithfully participated in weekly Mass.
