



Salvatore M. "Sal" D'Amico Jr.

September 24, 1928 - January 14, 2014

Mr. Salvatore M. "Sal" D'Amico, Jr., age 85, currently of Lauderdale Lakes, Florida, passed away on Tuesday, January 14, 2014 at the Florida Medical Center with the love and support of his family.

Born in Utica on September 24, 1928, Salvatore was the son of the late Salvatore, Sr. and Josephine (Testa) D'Amico. Raised and educated locally, he graduated from T.R. Proctor High School and attended M.V.C.C. where he earned his Associates Degree. A veteran of the United States Army, Sal honorably served his country from 1946-1948. On July 1, 1950, he married the former Angela M. Paciello with whom he shared 59 years in a beloved union focused around family. Angela passed away on April 7, 2010.

For almost 40 years, Sal worked as an engineer with the General Electric Company where he distinguished himself as a hard worker, detailed and structured in his projects. At home, he was a loving father and became a proud and happy grandfather and great-grandfather with the arrival of his descendants. His professional skills were applied at home as Sal was often called upon to help construct or offer his masterminding assistance as the go-to person when something needed fixing.
