Mr. Sam "Skane" Maggio, age 67, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, May 27, 2016 in Maryland.

Born in Utica on August 26, 1948, Sam was the son of the late Michele and Anna (Intino) Maggio. A straight-arrow and self-reliant young man he reached the highest level of achievement in scouting; an Eagle Scout. He was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School and continued his education at McPhearson College. Later in life he met and devoted himself to his longtime fiancée Angie Rutkowski of Ocean City, Maryland.

Besides Sam's intense love of family and friends, he had a lifelong passion for music.
