



Mr. Samuel J. "Sam" Marchione

October 2, 1916 - August 9, 2011

Mr. Samuel J. "Sam" Marchione, age 94, formerly of Auburn, and currently of Utica, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, August 9, 2011 at The Pines at Utica with the love of his family in his heart.

Samuel was born in Frankfort, NY on October 2, 1916, the son of the late John and Congetta (Perretta) Marchione. He was raised and educated in Utica schools and subsequently enlisted in the United States Army, where he honorably served his country during World War II.

During his youth, Sam was athletic and was known to be an excellent swimmer and a suave dancer. He was also a hard worker who focused his energies on caring for his parents and siblings. After serving his country, he remained active in the daily activities associated with the Veterans Administration Hospital Programs and was a lifetime member of the Disabled American Veterans. He was generous by nature, always willing to help others. Sam enjoyed the simple things in life, especially road trips in his favorite cars, and a scoop of ice cream on a summer's day. For relaxation he loved to listen to the radio, especially the music of Frank Sinatra, swing jazz of Benny Goodman, and the smooth songs of the Big Band era. Above all, he appreciated the love and kindness that his family and friends extended to him throughout the years, and he felt truly blessed that they were in his life.

Sam is survived by his sisters, Jennie T. Mucitelli, and Loretta M. Francis, both of Utica; his sister-in-law, Sara Marchione of Syracuse; his many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, great-great-nieces, great-great-

nephews, and numerous cousins. He was predeceased by his sisters and brothers-in-law, Connie and Joseph Razzano, Mary R. Lomonico, and Phyllis and Gerald Pastorelli; his brothers and sister-in-law, James Marchione, Charles and Nancy Marchione, and Joseph Marchione; and his brothers-in-law, Frank Mucitelli, and Albert Francis.
