



## Sarah E. Yeomans

June 25, 1938 - October 5, 2015

Sarah E. Yeomans, age 77, of Utica, passed away on Monday October 5, 2015 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with the love and support of her family.

Born in Utica on June 25, 1938, Sarah was the daughter of the late Herbert and Marion (Bendix) Yeomans. She was raised and educated locally.
