



Stanley Parkola

December 7, 1922 - July 31, 2013

Mr. Stanley Parkola, age 90, passed away on Wednesday, July 31, 2013 in the comfort of his home.

Born in Utica on December 7, 1922, Stanley was the son of the late Vincent and Anna (Wojecski) Parkola. A veteran of World War II, he honorably served his country in the United States Navy from 1942-1945. In 1950 he married the former Jessica M. "Jessie" Barile with whom he shared 56 years prior to her passing on February 7, 2006; throughout their life together, they were true companions and friends.

A draftsman by profession, Stanley worked at the Chicago Pneumatic Company for many years. He was a sociable, multi-faceted man endowed with the gift of making others smile, especially when he played his fiddle. To that end, he was affectionately known as the "Mad Fiddler" and would frequently be found at many local venues playing solo or joining in with other musical groups. He was a parishioner of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church. Stanley's love, life, and music will be remembered by his many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, and sisters-in-law, Sadie Parkola, and Olga Parkola. He was predeceased by his brothers, Anthony, Frank, Joseph, and Walter Parkola; and his sister, Julia Paciak.
