



Stanley F. "Bud" Penc

August 31, 1943 - August 15, 2013

Mr. Stanley F. "Bud" Penc, age 69, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, August 15, 2013 at his camp in Sylvan Beach.

Born in Utica on August 31, 1943, Stanley was the son of the late Stanley and Gladys (Gokey) Penc. Raised and educated locally, he was a graduate of Utica Free Academy. On May 14, 1966 in St. Mary's Church on South Street he married the former Adeline Schafer with whom he shared 47 years in a union of friendship and love, completed by their common commitment of family.

For a number of years, Bud worked as a driver for the ARC Oneida-Lewis Chapter helping to enable persons with disabilities to achieve their potential. A quiet and reserved man, Bud's family was his life. He truly enjoyed the time he spent with each of his loved ones, and he was especially proud of being a grandfather. Bud embraced the briskness of the cold winter months here at home, just as he found peace and tranquility at his summer camp at Sylvan Beach. As a sports enthusiast, his interests included playing in a fantasy baseball league. In the outdoors, he preferred fishing and boating on the Lake. He also pursued his passion for coin collecting. He was a faithful parishioner of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.

Bud is survived by his wife, Adeline; his daughter and son-in-law, Melissa and Duane Spignardo of Wallkill, NY; his sons and daughter-in-law, Drs. Stanley Penc and Maia Boswell-Penc of Slingerlands, NY, and Anthony "Tony" Penc of East Greenbush, NY; and his grandchildren, Adeline, Connor, Hunter, Olivia

Rose, Amelia, and Thatcher. Also left to mourn his untimely passing are his sisters and brother-in-law, Pat White of Malone, Barbara and Ronald Barcomb of Utica, Linda Fish of Sauquoit, and Debbie Penc of NY Mills.
