Mrs. Stella (Abramczyck) Lewek, age 96, formerly of Utica and more recently of New Hartford, passed away on Tuesday, August 24, 2010 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center.

Born in Utica on June 15, 1914, Stella was the daughter of the late Joseph and Veronica (Kulig) Abramczyck. She was raised and educated locally. In July of 1942 she married Michael F. Lewek with whom she shared 61 years in a loving union until his passing on May 14, 2003.

During her working years, Stella was employed by the Sperry Rand/Univac Corporation.
