endeavors. He considered his children a great blessing to him. As loving as Stephen was, he also wasn't afraid to place boundaries. If he wasn't interested in doing something, such as going to an event or outing, he would not go. When he said no, he meant it. Stephen was a man of his word, and in harmony with himself. His inner peace was solid.

A zealous outdoorsman, he loved nature. There were sports for every season. In the fall he hunted deer and turkey, and they gutted and dressed their trophy as a family. Dirt bike riding and racing, camping, and fishing filled their days. Winter was a slower time because of Stephen's physical limitations, but he still found the energy to snowmobile. And in the spring it began it all over again! Steve was a huge animal lover and made his pets part of the family. His late dog Baby Girl and feline Rusty filled many days of companionship. Edward and his current pet, Maine Coon were like two peas in a pod and he will be lost as well. When Stephen wasn't active outside, he was a great cook at home. Pastas in various presentations, always having Derek by his side, were created with recipes that were never written down. He also created chilis, stews, and sausage and onions to everyone's delight. Stephen and Ruth hosted great holidays where they gave precious gifts and they were full of the kids' desires. His sister Donna and her family were always a part of these occasions. They were the best of times and his presence will be horribly missed, but they will try their best to carry on the tradition. Spiritually, he knew of the Lord and believed in heaven, and missed those that went before him.

Stephen is survived by his best friend and devoted wife, Ruth. Stephen's children and their spouses also hold his memory close, Stephen J. Roman, Jr, Peter Roman and his wife, Britany Shawn Getz, and Derek M. Getz and Natasha Duncan. 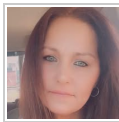
