



## Teresa E. (Coriale) DiGiorgio

June 7, 1916 - December 24, 2006

Mrs. Teresa E. (Coriale) DiGiorgio, age 90, of Schuyler and formerly of Utica, passed away peacefully in her sleep with her family by her side on Sunday, December 24, 2006 at home.
