UTICA – After a long life, Theresa (Mazzei) DiMeo, at 93, passed away on Saturday, June 8, 2024.

Born in Utica on April 16, 1931, Theresa was the daughter of the late Fred R. and Perley (Costanza) Mazzei. On September 16, 1950, she married John A. DiMeo. The couple shared over 43 years together prior to John's passing on January 3, 1994.

Theresa is survived by her daughter, Maryanne DiMeo. Theresa treasured the memory of her son, John F. DiMeo, who preceded her in death on November 13, 1974.
