Mrs. Theresa (Coriale) Marcantonio, a life long Utican, passed away peacefully on Thursday, September 25, 2014 at the Masonic Care Community of NY in the presence of her devoted sister Carmel, and her extended family. Theresa was the daughter of the late Dominick and Maria (Gioia) Coriale. Raised and educated locally, she was a 1930 graduate of Utica Free Academy. She continued her academic studies at the Oneonta State Teachers College graduating in 1933 with a life certificate in Elementary Education. On May 5, 1941 she married John Marcantonio; they were well-suited for one another and honored each other's life style which made for a harmonious relationship. Her beloved John passed away on December 29, 1966. Theresa began her professional career as a teacher with the Utica City School District in 1934. During her tenure with the Department of Education, she served as an evening school Teacher and Principal. Concurrently, she carried out her duties as a full time elementary education teacher. She mentored her students with dedication until her retirement in 1977. Theresa was a compassionate educator, touching the minds of the youth she taught, always loving them as her borrowed children. Through the years she was also loyal in assisting in the family business, Coriale Flowers. She had an affiliation with the Retired Utica Teachers Association, New York State United Teachers, National Retired Teachers Association, First Source Federal Credit Union, and the No Sew Club.

A woman of fortitude and grace, she was motherly in her love, support and

ability to keep all those she held close. Theresa was blessed with culinary talents and abilities that were delectable.

The testimony of her life will continue to be a blessing to many. She practiced her Catholic faith at St. Agnes Parish and was a member of the Christ Child Society at St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.
