



## Theresa A. (Trapasso) DeNigro

December 11, 1920 - December 4, 2005

Mrs. Theresa A. (Trapasso) DeNigro, age 84, of Utica, passed away on Sunday, December 4, 2005, at the Eden Park Health Care Center where she currently resided. Born in Utica on December 11, 1920, Theresa was the daughter of the late Louis and Rose (Gaetano) Trapasso. She was raised and educated locally. In June of 1941 she married Joseph A. DeNigro with whom she shared a union of 62 years prior to his passing on November 23, 2003. Mrs. DeNigro worked alongside her husband as he carried on the daily operation and management of their family business, Joe DeNigro Appliances. Well-known for its large and up-to-date stock, its maintenance and repair technology and its prompt, courteous, and complete service, the store was a successful and respected area enterprise from the day of its establishment in 1960 until its closing in 1982. Since then, Theresa had spent most of her retirement years in Naples, Florida, until fairly recently when she returned to Utica to be closer to her family. Locally she was a communicant of the Church of St. John the Evangelist in New Hartford. Mrs. DeNigro is survived by two sons and daughters-in-law, Joseph and Virginia "Ginger" DeNigro of San Diego, CA, and Robert and Susan DeNigro of Atlanta, GA; and her grandchildren, Kimberly, Mindy, Jill, and Jenna. She is also survived by a very special cousin, Elizabeth "Betty" Giruzzi of Utica; and her sister-in-law, Clare Trapasso of Utica. She was predeceased by a brother, Anthony J. "Slim" Trapasso.
