Mr. Thomas A. "Tom" Colangelo, age 60, of Utica, passed away on Thursday, February 10, 2011 at Strong Memorial Hospital with his loving family by his side.

Born in Utica on April 22, 1950, Thomas was the son of the late Frank A. "Hank" and Mary (Lucas) Colangelo. Raised and educated locally, he was a 1968 graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. On August 16, 1997 he married the former Cynthia S. "Cindy" Cavalier with whom he shared a union based on love and mutual friendship and respect.

Tom was employed by the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center as an Anesthesia Technician and care attendant, the position from which he recently retired in January 2011.
