Mr. Thomas Anthony Scalzi, age 82, of New Hartford, passed away on Monday, October 29, 2007 at the Charles T. Sitrin Health Care Center. Born on April 4, 1925, Thomas was the son of the late Philip and Frances (Bruni) Scalzi. He was raised and educated locally. A veteran of World War II, he served his country in the U.S. Navy.
