Tim Mishalanie, professionally known as Tim Mish, age 48, of Utica, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, October 7, 2009.

Born in New Hartford on January 14, 1961, Tim was the son of the late Joseph and Linda (Kilgore) Mishalanie. Raised and educated locally, he attended J.F. Hughes Elementary School and was a 1979 graduate of Utica Free Academy.

Tim was a classically trained professional keyboardist and pianist. A diversified and passionate musician, he was co-founder of BigKrush, performing adult oriented rock. Their music was well renowned even in Europe. His untimely passing has caused a clamorous response from fans throughout the world. Tim did things in his life with great passion, and he was a great and admired friend. A man with a big heart and a charismatic personality, he had the funniest one-liners, and made a “party happen” just by his presence. He also loved the outdoors and could be seen with a cigar and a smile on his face when he was fishing a stream. He was also a golfer and shared the fairways with his brother, Joe, as well as the love of music with his brother, Bob. He was a great cook, and he loved to partake of his culinary creations. Those who knew and loved him can honor his life by keeping a special moment of him in their hearts and continue being his greatest fans by listening to his music.

Tim is survived by his brothers, Robert Mishalanie, Joseph Mishalanie, Jr., and Robert Acquaviva; and his cousins, aunts, and uncles. He also leaves his

bandmates, friends of his sporting events, and a host of friends and fans who were so important to him.

Visitation will be held Wednesday from 4:00-7:00 at the Eannace Funeral Home, Inc., 932 South St., corner of Hammond Ave. For those wishing to do so, please consider memorial contributions in Tim's honor to the family to assist them during this difficult time; envelopes will be available at the funeral home. Tim's Christian Spirituality will be celebrated by his friends immediately upon the conclusion of visitation. Interment will take place in Calvary Cemetery at the convenience of the family.
