He was active in sports, including softball, tennis, bowling, archery, golf, and fishing, especially with his dad. Trey loved animals to the point where he interned at the Crossbay Animal Clinic, run by Dr. Weinstein who for many years has been contracted with The Port Authority of New York & New Jersey to examine and hold in quarantine, by law, all animals coming into this country. He was a good guy with a gentle soul ... a bright light is gone from this world!!!
