



Vickey Elizabeth (Crockett) Taylor

July 23, 1957 - June 26, 2020

UTICA/LEWISTON, ME - Vickey Elizabeth (Crockett) Taylor, age 62, passed away unexpectedly from complications with diabetes on Friday, June 26, 2020 at MVHS at St. Elizabeth Medical Center with her loving family by her side. Born in Lewiston, Maine on July 23, 1957, Vickey was the daughter of the late Phyllis Crockett and Clifton "Kip" Richmond. Raised and educated in Maine, she was a 1976 graduate of Winthrop High School. She moved to Utica to attend Truck Driving School where she obtained her Commercial Driver's License (CDL).

Vickey worked as a school bus driver for the Utica City School District for 18 years, beginning with the Albany Street School route, then the Proctor High School route, often remembering the students she safely transported. Vickey loved animals, especially her canine companion "Hadji". She also had a special fondness for wolves. She was a New England Patriots football fan and a Boston Red Sox baseball buff. Occasionally, she could be quite funny, and she enjoyed dining out at the Castlewood Cafe and the Riverside Diner, for the food and friends. She was proud of her Irish and Scottish heritage, and she had an interest in reading historical World War II books. Vickey was a person of faith and her Bible was well read through. Her role as "Grandma" was cherished.

Vickey is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Jean and Roger Rebisz, and their daughter Chloe Rebisz; her son, Timothy S. "Timmy" Taylor; and her sisters and family, Pat Crockett, and Penny and Bryan Bolstridge and their son
