



## Victor Bigun

June 8, 1927 - July 10, 2012

Mr. Victor Bigun, age 85, of Utica, passed away on Tuesday, July 10, 2012 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center.

Born in Kiev, Ukraine on June 8, 1927, Victor was the son of the late Dimitri and Vera Bigun. He was raised and educated in the Ukraine, and as a young man he came to this country with his family where he has since resided. At one time, he was married to the former Jane E. Wentka.

Victor's working career revolved around the exciting sport of horse racing; he was employed as a horse race inspector with the State of New York. An intelligent and venturesome man, he was a successful entrepreneur in his younger years. Above all, Victor was a good man and a loving father. He professed his faith at the Cathedral of Our Lady of Great Grace.
