Mr. Vincent Thomas DeBuono, age 83, passed away on Monday, August 4, 2014 in the comfort of his home with his loving family by his side.

Born in Yonkers, New York on June 23, 1931, Vincent was the son of the late Vincent and Anna Rosa (Marchese) DeBuono. He was also blessed with the love and guidance of Margaret "Chickie" De Buono. He was raised and educated in Yonkers. A proud veteran, Vincent honorably served his country with both the United States Navy and the United States Air Force. Following his military tour of duty, he furthered his studies at Westchester Community College where he received an Associate Degree.
