



## Virginia (Serway) Traglia

August 3, 1929 - January 9, 2010

Mrs. Virginia (Serway) Traglia, age 80, of Utica, passed from the hands of her family into the arms of Jesus on Saturday, January 09, 2010. Her passing occurred unexpectedly at the Upstate Medical University, Syracuse. Born in Frankfort, NY on August 3, 1929, Virginia was the daughter of the late Fargo and Emily (Karouf) Serway. Raised and educated in Frankfort, she was a graduate of Frankfort High School. On October 8, 1949 she married her love, Frank F. Traglia, and the blessing of their 60 years together enriched each other's lives.

Virginia graced her family with love and devotion, and she was the "heart of the home". She exemplified the true meaning of motherhood which was her greatest achievement and joy. She sacrificed to provide a loving home for her children and her efforts were reciprocated with their respect and admiration. She expressed constant concern for her children, and her family and friends will hold her gentle soul and caring heart in their treasured memories. She enjoyed the pastime of preparing meals to delight her family and much centered around her kitchen table. For leisure entertainment she shared in the excitement of Bingo and the slot machines at the casino. Most importantly, it was Virginia's faith that sustained her existence and guided her life. She was a member of the Knights of St. John Ladies' Auxiliary and a parishioner of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.

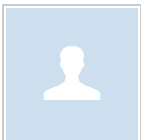
