Mr. Vito "Jack" Getti, Jr., of Utica, age 71, passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 5, 2015 at the Masonic Care Community of NY. Born in Utica on May 23, 1944, Vito was the son of the late Vito "Jack", Sr. and Elvira D. (Amadio) Getti. He was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1961. He continued his education at Utica College of Syracuse University where he was awarded a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration. On June 29, 1985 he married the former Frances Brutto with whom he shared 30 years; they were a couple that watched over one another and honored their marriage vows.

During his professional career as a Certified Financial Planner at Ameriprise Financial Services, Inc., Jack was dedicated to his clients and their investment concerns for many years. At the present time, he enjoyed working and was semi-retired. Both at home and at work, Jack was a mentor, a man of integrity, and a major source of admiration. He was a valued and honest financial advisor, and he was also a devoted husband, adoring father, and a treasured grandfather. A true gentleman, he had a grand sense of humor and a kind, generous heart. As the patriarch of his family, he was perceptive and insightful in assessing and solving the ups and downs of situations that arise in everyday life, and he was always a phone call away with wise advice. Jack was a protective, patient father with a primary concern for the wellbeing of his family. A loving and light-hearted grandpa, he took a great interest in the lives of his grandchildren and in turn, they felt comfortable going to him for any of

their needs. Jack enjoyed working around his home where he truly was a Jack-of-all-trades! Blessed with an intuitive ability to appreciate music, he was a self-taught acoustic guitar player with accompanying vocals that entertained friends and family. He and his wife savored the warm weather when he wintered at Ft. Myers Beach in Florida. Jack had a passion for the game of golf and an allegiance to the NY Giants and the NY Yankees. He was a 47-year member of the Masonic Lodge, dating back to the years when it was known as the Carducci Fellowcraft Club. He was a communicant of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish.

Vito is survived by his wife, Frances; his children, Lisa and Brian Kempisty of Syracuse, and Jeffrey and Stephie Getti of Whitesboro; and his grandchildren, Brianna, and Jaeden Kempisty; Owen Getti; and Olivia McArthur.
