You could always find him in his signature attire of flip flops, shorts, and a cut off shirt, no matter the time of year. Music was his life, wherever there was music was where he wanted to be. He loved his friendship with the late Freddy Piperata, a local musician whom he adored. William was very meticulous, especially when it came to exterior of his home; he loved maintaining everything to a "T" and also enjoyed gardening. He annually held "Mr. P's Pitch Tournament" for 36 years straight.
